4th Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill - RDs' Spiels

RD CAR: Maligayang pagbati sa ating mga kasamahan sa Kagawaran ng Edukasyon! First of all, we give thanks to the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC) for leading the conduct of the quarterly Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill.

- **RD NCR:** We would like to thank Secretary Leonor Magtolis Briones through the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) for encouraging the participation of all DepEd stakeholders in the quarterly NSED and, most notably, our Regional, Division and School DRRM Coordinators in making all NSED activities a success.
- **RD 1:** We have faced numerous challenges due to the COVID-19 pandemic, yet we continue to prioritize earthquake drills and practice the "duck, cover, and hold" in our offices, schools and at home while observing the minimum health protocols.
- **RD 2:** To reduce and manage risks, we highly regard the safety of our teachers and learners, especially our teachers, who are our education frontliners that ensure the learning continuity of learners.
- **RD 3:** Earthquakes strike without warning. Therefore, we recognize the importance of earthquake drills above all earthquake preparedness measures.
- **RD 4A:** The ground shaking during the earthquake is not the leading cause of injury or loss of life and it is mainly due to falling objects, weak infrastructure and collapsing walls or roofs.
- **RD 4B:** Therefore, it is essential for us to check the structural integrity of our homes, offices and schools to avoid injury or loss of life.
- **RD 5:** Apart from earthquake drills, lahat dapat tayo ay may nakahandang Go Bag na naglalaman ng First Aid Kit, Hygiene Kit, Survival Kit, pagkain, damit at beddings, gamit pang komunikasyon at impormasyon, at mahahalagang dokumento.
- **RD 6:** We also continuously strive for stronger coordination with the Local/Municipal/Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction Management Councils on disaster preparedness activities.
- **RD 7:** To further raise awareness, we also intensify our Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) campaign through the Adventures of Ready Kid Episodes produced by the DRRMS.
- **RD 8:** Again, we would like to emphasize that everyone must learn and practice the "duck, cover, and hold" whether you are in your offices, schools or at home. We must all be prepared in times of an earthquake.
- **RD 9:** We must know how to respond appropriately and what to do before, during and after an earthquake.
- **RD 10:** To react quickly, we must practice often, and that is why we participate in the quarterly NSED and aim for a higher participation rate every quarter.
- **RD 11:** Tayo rin ay patuloy na naghahanda para sa anumang sakuna na maaring dumating through the activities led by the DRRMS.

RD 12: We recognize that earthquake drills are a whole-of-society approach and unified efforts of National Government Agencies to build disaster-resilient schools and communities.

RD CARAGA: Therefore, even in times of the pandemic, the Department of Education, through the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS), will continue our advocacy to strengthen disaster preparedness and participate in all programs led by the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council through the Office of the Civil Defense.

VIDEO GUIDELINES

- 1. Record your video in landscape mode. The frame should be of a head-to-shoulder medium shot, with enough headspace.
- 2. Record in your office, or a plain background, and quiet area with no echo and noise.
- 3. Place yourself in an area with enough light on your face and background. You may use LED ring light if available.
- 4. Look straight to the camera and count five seconds after pressing the record and saying the statement. Say the line with clarity and remain calm.
- 5. You may translate your lines to your local or native language or revise as needed.
