Subject: TRAIN THE TRAINER PROGRAM

The Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) through the Information and Communications Technology Service-Educational Technology Unit (ICTS-EdTech), in collaboration with Microsoft Philippines, supported by LINE Learning and Development Solutions, will conduct **Train the Trainer Program** for identified **Microsoft Education Ambassadors (MEA).** This shall follow the schedule indicated in **Annex A.** The said activity aims to ensure that the content is aligned to the tools being rolled-out by the Department and to the multiple teaching and learning modalities.

Kindly refer to the following activity guidelines:

- 1. All training sessions for MEAs will be conducted via Microsoft Teams in the DepEd tenant.
- 2. Communication to join sessions will be cascaded through the Microsoft Teams site for MEAs.
- 3. The full list of identified MEAs who are eligible to join the training session is published in https://tinyurl.com/MEATrainingParticipants.
- 4. As part of the program's fulfillment, all MEAs will be required to redeliver the training they have acquired to at least 50 DepEd educators or to a school assigned to them through an online/webinar-style delivery.
- 5. Trainees of MEAs will use the DepEd PD-LMS (https://training.deped.gov.ph/) for skills validation upon completion of training.
