PACKAGES UNDER FY2019

The Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) received a letter from Columbia Technologies, Inc., DepEd Computerization Program (DCP) 2019 Suppliers, explaining what transpired during the delivery of the following in the Divisions of Iloilo City, Iloilo Province and Negros Occidental: (1) Batch 2019-01: G4-6 ICT Package, (2) Batch 2019-02: JHS/SHS ICT Package, and (3) Batch 2019-03: E-textbooks.

Based on the supplier's report (Annex A), Mr. Nilo Toroballes questioned the software installed on the tablets and laptops (Windows 10 Education and MS Office ProPlus 2019) against what was reflected on the supplier's Delivery Receipts (DR) and DepEd Inspection and Acceptance Report (IAR) (Windows 10 Professional – Shape the future and MS Office 365). Both Mr. Taroballes and Mr. Ariel Ballega, Information Technology Officers (ITOs) of Negros Occidental, instructed the supplier to make amendments on the DR, IAR and Property Transfer Receipts (PTR).

Please note the following provisions of OUA MEMO 00-0820-0093 dated 17 August 2020 (Annex B):

A. DCP DEPLOYMENT:

 Only the Supply Officer/Property Custodian shall receive the delive whether the school is ready or not.

C. SIGNING OF IAR and PTR:

1. An inspection will be made on the delivered items by the School Inspectorate Team. The School Inspectorate Team shall sign the Inspection Report if the deliveries comply with the requirements; if not, the deliveries will be rejected. The School Inspectorate Team shall see to it that the following requirements are complied with:

1.1 Inspection of DCP Packages:

- 1.1.1 Verify that what was stated in the IAR conforms to actual equipment delivered (technical specifications including the product description, model, brand, and product/serial numbers).
- 1.1.2 Verify the quantity stated in the IAR against the actual quantity delivered.
- 1.1.3 Inspect for damage.

The email sent to the Information and Communications Technology Service (ICTS) on **Windows 10 Professional – Shape the future** and **Windows 10 Education** shows that the latter is more advantageous to the government, because it offers more features (Annex C).

On the issue involving **MS Office ProPlus 2019** installed on the DCP packages, please consider that the ICTS issued a Memorandum (Annex D) which shows that MS Office ProPlus 2019 is under a **perpetual license**, while MS Office 365 is under a **termbased (subscription) license.** The latter requires connection to the Office Licensing Service via the internet at least once every 30 days.

The Administrative Service - Asset Management Division (AS-AMD) has not received any report from the Division Supply Officers/School Property Custodians on the said matter. The Division ITOs are advised to coordinate with the Division Suppliers Officers on the deployment and delivery of DCP Packages.

In this regard, the OUA hereby informs the supplier to immediately deliver the DCP packages to the recipient schools. Upon delivery, the School Inspectorate Team shall conduct inspection based on existing protocols and in the presence of the School Property Custodian.

Dear Dir. Abanil,

In reference to the above-mentioned project, we would like to raise our concern on our deliveries for licilo City, licilo Provinces and Negros Occidental. Initially, there was no problem encountered during the delivery as we only ask the schools to accept the CTI DRs. The problem arose during the setup and installation where the Regional ITO from Ilcilo City, Mr. Nilo Taroballes questioned the software installed on the tablets and laptops (Windows 10 Education and MS Office ProPlus 2019) against what was reflected on the CTI DR and DepEd IAR (Windows 10 Professional – Shape the Future and MS Office 365).

As per TOR, the software to be installed are Windows 10 Professional (Shape the Future) SKU with Antivirus and latest MS Office (with installer and licensed key to be provided by DepEd). During our project implementation meeting last January 2020, it was discussed that we shall be using the MS Office 365 (as this is the latest version of MS Office). When we prepared the CTI DRs and requested for the IAR, the softwares that we indicated are: Windows 10 Professional (Shape the Future) and MS Office 365.

When the laptops and tablets arrived at our warehouse, we were required to activate the product keys of the Operating System. The activation key was provided to us by DepEd. When it was activated, the Operating System became Windows 10 Education. For the MS Office, the product key that was given to us by DepEd is MS Office ProPlus 2019.

Despite our effort to explain to the Regional ITO that these softwares were provided for by DepEd (copy of the Software Amendments made by ICTS has also been sent to him by Engr. Ofelia Algo), he dropped a remark that "it's either we change what is reflected on the documents (CTI DR, DepEd IAR and PTR) or change the preloaded software on the units". The same order was given by the Regional ITO of Negros Occidental, Mr. Ariel Ballega who instructed the schools to make amendments on the documents (erase and update the software as per delivery). Please note that erasures in the delivery documents shall not be allowed by your Accounting Division.

CHRISTIAN &

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In this regard, we would like to inform you that we cannot continue with our deployment on the said provinces if they will insist on making erasures on the CTI and DepEd documents. Likewise, we cannot ask our regional partners to travel to those areas without the guarantee that they will sign the delivery documents. It will incur additional expense going back to school several times just to secure the signature of the documents.

We just want to reiterate that the Operating System and the MS Office shown on the CTI DR & DepEd IAR was based on what was written in the TOR. If we are going to change the delivery documents and indicate the amended softwares, we might encounter problem with your Accounting Division once they check these documents. Besides, we're almost done with the deliveries in Regions III, V and NCR and we didn't encounter any problem with them.

We hope you can help us settle this matter so we can resume the delivery and finish this project at the soonest possible time.

A. DCP DEPLOYMENT:

- 1. The Goods and Services shall be delivered to the Project sites / recipient schools, within two hundred ten (210) days from issuance of the Notice to Proceed.
- 2. The Asset Management Division / Supply Office will inform the Division Supply Officers of the deliveries to be made by the suppliers and provide them a copy of the distribution list and schedule of deliveries.
- 3. The DCP Package can only be unloaded when authorized School Personnel like School Property Custodian and the School Inspectorate Team are present. If the School Property Custodian is not present nor available during the arrival of the DCP package at the school, the School Head/ Principal should appoint an alternate School Property Custodian that will handle the delivery for this project.
- 4. Only the Supply Officer / Property Custodian shall receive the deliveries whether the school is ready or not.
- 5. Deliveries after 5pm, holidays including Saturdays and Sundays can be accommodated on a case to case basis and with prior coordination with the School Property Custodian and IT Officers.
- 6. However, during the actual delivery of DCP packages, if the Supplier found that the recipient school is closed or un-energized or have no available Classroom/ makeshift structures, the Supplier shall deliver the packages to the Division or District Office. The Supply Officer shall perform an initial checking of the delivered DCP package as to physical conditions of the boxes, quantity and if accordance to the items specified in the Inspection and Acceptance Report (IAR).

7. In case the Supplier/Forwarder or School Property Custodian notices that some items are missing or damaged, Supplier should replace the missing/damaged items or opt to restrict further opening of the boxes pending an investigation of the incident for the protection of the Supplier and the recipient. Deliveries should be rejected if found to be NOT in accordance with conditions stated in IAR.

B. UPON DELIVERY OF THE GOODS TO THE PROJECT SITES / RECIPIENT SCHOOLS:

1. The supplier/forwarder shall bring the following documents to recipient schools and turned over to the School Property Custodian or designated alternate:

1.1 Delivery Receipt;

1.2 Property Transfer Report (PTR);

1.3 Inspection and Acceptance Report (IAR); and

1.4 Training Checklist

 The School Property Custodian (or designated alternate) shall perform an initial checking for the delivered DCP package as to physical conditions of the boxes, quantity and if conforms to the items specified in the Inspection and Acceptance Report (IAR) prior to signing of Delivery Receipt.

C. SIGNING OF INSPECTION AND ACCEPTANCE REPORT (IAR) AND PROPERTY TRANSFER REPORT (PTR)

1. An inspection will be made on the delivered items by the School Inspectorate Team. The School Inspectorate Team shall sign the Inspection Report if the deliveries comply with the requirements; if not, the deliveries will be rejected. The School Inspectorate Team shall see to it that the following requirements are complied with:

1.1 <u>Inspection of DCP Packages:</u>

- 1.1.1 Verify that what was stated in the IAR conforms to actual equipment delivered (technical specifications including the product description, model, brand, and product / serial numbers).
- 1.1.2 Verify the quantity stated in the IAR against the actual quantity delivered.

1.1.3 Inspect for damage.

1.2 Check for Operability / Functionality

1.2.1 Batch 2019-01: G4-6 ICT Package

1.3 Training Requirements

1.3.1 Training stated above shall be provided for at least two (2) teachers from each recipient school. Attendees must

include the school's designated ICT Coordinator and Division IT Officer.

1.3.2 Training manuals in hardcopies and soft copies (in DVD) shall be provided per recipient school.

1.3.3 Training shall be conducted in the recipient school installed IT equipment and be done during school hours, unless the school head and teachers request to be trained after school or teaching hours.

1.3.4 Training manuals shall be signed by the participants after completing the required hours of training and certified by the supplier and the ICT Coordinator.

D. AFTER THE DELIVERIES OF THE GOODS TO THE PROJECT SITES / RECIPIENT SCHOOLS:

- The supplier shall bring the following documents back to DepEd ICTS TID:
 - 1.1 Signed Delivery Receipts
 - 1.2 Signed Inspection and Acceptance Report (IAR)
 - 1.3 Signed Property Transfer Report (PTR)
- 2. The School Property Custodian shall keep the school copy of the above documents.

E. AFTERSALES SUPPORT:

- 1. A three (3)-year comprehensive and onsite warranty for the whole IT Equipment package including networking peripherals and for operation and maintenance of all licensed software products will be applied. The 3-year period shall reckon from the date of issuance of the Certification of Final Acceptance by the DepEd that the delivered goods and services have been duly inspected and accepted (final acceptance).
- 2. For the following consumable items, a standard/base warranty or minimum of one (1) year warranty shall be applied:
 - 2.1 Laptop and Tablet Batteries
 - 2.2 Headsets
 - 2.3 Optical Mouse for Laptops
- 3. Upon receipt by the Supplier of the Procuring Entity's notice of any claims arising under this warranty, the Supplier shall immediately act upon to repair or replace the defective Goods or parts thereof. The period for correction of defects in the warranty period is within seven (7) calendar days from receipt of such notice.
- 4. For defects arising from within the first-half of the warranty period, as applicable, DepEd may opt to demand for recall and replacement of the defective items.

- 5. On the other hand, defects arising from the onset until the expiry of the warranty period, DepEd may ask for repairs of the defective items.
- 6. The Supplier shall be liable for the damages for the delay in its performance of the Contract and shall pay DepEd liquidated damages, not by way of penalty, in an amount equal to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of the delayed goods scheduled for delivery for every day of delay until such goods are finally delivered and accepted by DepEd. DepEd shall deduct the liquidated damages from any money due or which may become due to the Supplier or collect from any of the securities or warranties posted by the Supplier, whichever is convenient. Once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the Contract, DepEd may rescind the Contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.
- 7. The Division IT Officers must consolidate all unresolved issues from the recipient schools and submit to Regional IT Officers. The Regional IT Officers must transmit all unresolved issues to dcp.recipients@deped.gov.ph. The TID-ICTS to forward all concerns to the appropriate supplier. The Supplier must respond reports indicating resolved, pending and closed issues to DepEd ICTS Technology Infrastructure Division.
- 8. DepEd TID-ICTS accommodates non-supplier action report at icts.tid@deped.gov.ph.
- F. Please refer to **DepEd Order No. 42 s.2018** Updated Guidelines on Delivery, Inspection, Acceptance and Recording of DepEd Procured Assets.
