PROJECT EVALUATION OF THE DEVELOPMENT SUPPORT SERVICES (DSS) AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE (TA) TO THE DEPED COMPUTERIZATION PROGRAM (DCP) TO THE K TO 12 PROGRAM IMPLEMENTED IN PARTNERSHIP WITH UNITED

NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (UNDP)

In 2016, the Department of Education (DepEd) partnered with the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) in the implementation of the DepEd Computerization Program (DCP) to the K to 12 Program. Through this program, the DepEd mobilized the UNDP through the National Acceleration Modality (NAM) in the procurement, delivery, and installation of about 4,800 ICT packages to schools from 2016 to 2019.

As part of the Terminal Evaluation of this program, there are three (3) surveys conducted on the following program components:

- 1. Utilization of ICT packages for students' learning and its current operational status at the school level;
- 2. Operational status of ICT packages distributed to Division offices; and
- 3. DepEd-Civil Society Organization (CSO) partnership in terms of ascertaining school readiness and on the delivery and installation of ICT packages and solar panels.

The 1st set of survey questionnaires on ICT packages would need the participation of teachers and ICT Coordinators or Focal Persons. The 2nd set of survey questionnaires on ICT packages would need the participation of teachers and ICT Coordinators or Focal Persons.
