The Philippines has experienced the longest national school closure in the region and given the overwhelming evidence regarding the negative consequences of prolonged school closures on the learning, development, and overall well-being of children, the safe resumption of in-person schooling should be thoroughly planned based on evidence. As such, a second Health-Education Discussion will be undertaken to focus on how to safely reopen schools guided by experts in both fields. The participants will provide insights for the Department of Education's consideration as it develops a roadmap for the resumption of in-person learning that can be proposed to the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Diseases.
